The beautiful deep, opaque ruby color provides a visual clue to the ripeness, which shows again in aromas of mixed berry fruit jam and vanilla. The full mid-palate is framed with lively acidity that gives way to velvety soft tannin in the finish. This is a very versatile food wine!
